- 4) I commit to attending the Sinkhole Conference and presenting the paper described by the above-listed abstract title, and understand that if am not able to attend the entire conference and personally present that paper for whatever reason, I will forfeit the waived fees and reimbursement benefits of the Beck Scholarship;
- 5) I agree to give the Sinkhole Conference and its organizers permission to use the photograph of myself and modify my statement of my career biography and interests to publicize my receipt of the Beck Scholarship and the Sinkhole Conference, and that I will be given the opportunity to review my modified statement and approve it prior to publication;
